


Figure 1. Percent distribution of respondent stakeholder




Figure 2 Pie chart of students feed on Objectives and outcome of curriculum




Figure 3 - Students feedback on allocation of teaching hours




Figure 4 - Students feedback on advanced knowledge offered in curriculum




Figure 5 - Students feedback on availability of learning resources




Figure 6 - Students feedback on enhancing technical skill and problem solving ability 76.6% of the student respondent agree that curriculum enhances technical skill and problem solving ability (Figure 6).




Figure 7 - Teachers feedback on curriculums accordance with UGC guidelines 90.2% of the teacher agree that curriculum prescribed follows the UGC guidelines (Figure 7).




Figure 8 - Teachers feedback on distribution of contact hours




Figure 9 - Teachers feedback on system followed by university for curriculum design, development and implementation




Figure 10 - Teachers feedback on advancement in subject incorporated in curriculum 74.5 % of the teacher respondent agree that curriculum deals with advancement in subject.




Figure 11 - Teacher feedback on curriculum to impart professional skills enhancing employability of the student.




Figure 12 - Alumni feedback on curriculum bridging gap between conventional and modern knowledge




Figure 13 - Alumni feedback on students self-learning and extra-learning




Figure 14 - Alumni feedback on curriculum offering basic and professional skills required for career development.




Figure 15 - Alumni feedback on curriculums role in inspiring student for opting higher studies.




Figure 16 - Alumni feedback on holistic development of the student
